

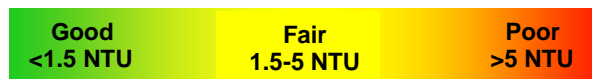

## **Duteau Creek Water Source** **WATER QUALITY UPDATE**

Regional District of North Okanagan – Greater Vernon Water (RDNO-GVWU) and Interior Health Authority (IHA) advises that the water quality from the **Duteau Creek Water Source** has a “**GOOD**” rating.



### **How is water treated to protect public health?**

The Duteau Creek water source is currently treated at the Duteau Creek Water Treatment Plant. Organic particles are removed through a process called Dissolved Air Flootation (DAF) and then chlorinated.

### **What does a GOOD rating mean?**

A good rating means the water is safe to drink for all customers with the exception of those customers with weakened immune systems.

### **What should customers with weakened immune systems do?**

Customers with weakened immune systems should ask their doctor or specialist whether they need to take extra precautions. The following Health Link BC provides further information:
